

factsheet Classic Days 2023 (English version)

- Classic Days have always taken place on the first weekend in August since the 2006 first edition, in 2023: from 4-6 August. Friday, 4.8. from 10 a.m. 6 p.m., Saturday, 5.8. from 9 a.m. 6 p.m. and Sunday, 6.8. from 9 a.m. 5 p.m..
- Access roads will be open from 7:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. For visitors, the Classic Days recommend the use of public transport, for which the ticket price is already included in event-tickets that have been purchased online.
- The Festival of Culture and Motoring Lifestyle has been held 14 times on the left bank of the Rhine around Schloss Dyck. In 2020 and 2021 it had to pause due to the pandemic. Since 2022 it is held in a larger area and with improved infrastructure in the state capital Düsseldorf.
- The venue of the 16th Classic Days is the "Green Park", which is a Classic-Days-internal name. In the "real world", the place is called much more simply "P1" and is part of the Düsseldorf fairgrounds' car park.
- The "Green Park" owes its Classic Days name to its approximately 1,500 shady deciduous trees and the well-tended meadow ground. The otherwise so mundane car park is transformed into more than a dozen themed worlds where lovingly decorated and visitors dressed in period clothing to match the vintages of their vehicles create their own relaxed picnic atmosphere. Spectacular vehicles on the circuit, lively exhibition areas, dealer areas and stylish catering contribute to the special ambience, as do celebrities and motorsport legends.
- The organisers expect over the complete weekend 35- to 50,000 visitors and approx. 5,000 to 7,000 classic cars and youngtimers.
- Despite the thematic focus on 137 years of motor vehicle history, the Classic Days
 are by no means only and exclusively a car event. The event is family-friendly,
 opulent in its imagery and a relaxing journey through time with endless opportunities
 for discovery, much lifestyle and summer garden partying.
- The festival is organised by the volunteer association Classic Days e.V. It organises the event to raise funds for charitable and social purposes. In 2023, one beneficiary of this commitment will be the "giving back" foundation.
